FUND RAISING PROJECTS

MSD 1084

The Board recognizes the responsibility of the District to provide an equal educational opportunity for all students and will provide the best possible educational program with the resources available. Such resources shall not include solicitation of funds from District residents. Furthermore, the relationship between the community and District is improved when members of the community are not asked to donate to such solicitations.

However, students can gain valuable educational experiences from sales to the public which also support a desired project for those students. Accordingly, only the following projects shall be approved:

1. Grade Eleven will be allowed to sell magazine subscriptions.
2. The Future Farmers of America (FFA) will be allowed to sell fruit.
3. The Senior High FBLA Club (Future Business Leaders of America) shall be allowed to conduct an annual fund-raising project.
4. "In House" projects used by clubs, which must be approved by the respective building principals.
5. Other fund-raising projects as approved by the Superintendent, or designee.

Church groups, service clubs, and activities of parent groups are not school sponsored and are not covered by this policy.
