Guidance and Counseling Program

The School District will provide a guidance and counseling program that is available to every student. The Superintendent or designee shall direct the District's guidance and counseling program.

Each staff member is responsible for effectively guiding students under his/her supervision in order to provide early identification of intellectual, emotional, social, or physical needs, diagnosis of any learning disabilities, and the development of educational potential. The District's counselors shall offer counseling to those students who require additional assistance.
