

Regulation

PRIVATELY OWNED VEHICLES

The School Business Administrator/Board Secretary, in collaboration with the Superintendent and/or Principal, shall supplement the transportation resources of the district by identifying qualified school personnel who are willing to provide transportation for district pupils to and from school-related activities or when the need arises in emergency situations between school and home.

Qualifications shall include:

1. A valid New Jersey driver's license;
2. A private passenger vehicle of nine or fewer capacity, with a current New Jersey or other inspection sticker; and
3. Evidence of Personal Automobile Coverage on the vehicle to be driven of at least a \$500,000 Bodily Injury & Property Damage Combined Single Limit of Liability Each Accident.

In determining the appropriateness of utilizing private vehicles, the following shall be considered:

1. District approval of activities involved;
2. District determination of drivers and assignment of students to them;
3. Student safety in pick-up, transit, use of safety belts and drop off;
4. Adequate supervision of students at the activity.
