FAMILY LIFE EDUCATION

The family life curriculum is developed and coordinated through the superintendent or his/her designee, ensuring the articulation from the elementary schools to the middle school. The curriculum shall be available for review upon request.

Parents/guardians of all students shall be informed about the specifics of the curriculum through an annual notification and shall be told that:

- A. A student may be excused from any part of the instruction that is in conflict with their conscience or religious or moral beliefs;
- B. A written, signed statement from the parent/guardian submitted to the principal is required to excuse a student from family life education;
- C. The statement must specify the parent/guardian's objections;
- D. Alternative instructional content and activities shall be provided for excused students.
