COMMUNITY RESOURCES

The school staff should be active in locating and contacting people in many areas of interest. In addition to seeking out individuals directly, contacts can be made through pupils in the classrooms, and through school-community associations.

Letters or other contacts requesting any assistance from such a person, whether voluntary or for a fee, must be cleared through the office of the chief school administrator.

A letter of appreciation should always be sent to those members of the community who contribute to the program of the school.

The principal may be asked from time to time to provide the superintendent with a summary of the extent and effect of the use of such individuals.

The superintendent's designee shall develop a community resource list by such categories as will be helpful to the education of the pupils.
