

PARTICIPATION IN ACADEMIC-ORIENTED COMPETITIONS

Students from MSAD #11 often participate in academic-oriented, school-sanctioned activities that provide opportunities to compete at the regional and national level. The Board wishes to recognize and support students who participate in academic-oriented national competitions such as Destination Imagination and VICA, within its overall budget constraints.

A student or team of students may apply to the MSAD #11 Board for reimbursement of actual expenses incurred in participating in an academic-oriented competition up to \$250 for an individual or up to \$1,000 for a team. Application for reimbursement must be made in writing and include documentation that the student(s) have engaged in fundraising to defray expenses. Such fundraising must have been conducted in accordance with the Board's policy JJE—Student Fundraising Activities. The Board will make decisions regarding reimbursement on a case-by-case basis.
