Graduation Pathways					
In addition to current course requirements, students must meet one of the following three pathways to earn a diploma:					
1	Earn a cumulative passing score of 18 on seven end-of course exams. To ensure students are well rounded, they must earn a minimum of four points in math, four points in English and six points across science and social studies. The scores will be set by the State Board of Education. Courses that have an end of course exam include English I, English II, Algebra, Geometry, Biology, American history, and American government.				
2	Students earn "remediation-free" scores in English language arts and mathematics on a nationally recognized college admission exam. A remediation free score is English (18), Reading (22), and Math (22). The state of Ohio will pay one time for all 11th grade students in the classes of 2018 and beyond to take the ACT free of charge.				
3	Students earn 12 points through a State Board of Education-approved, industry-recognized credential or group of credentials in a single career field and achieve a workforce readiness score of 13 on the WorkKeys assessment. The state of Ohio will pay one time for those who take the WorkKeys assessment.
