The meeting was called to order at 5:15 pm

The Secretary's report was emailed to the group by Jessica Davis—Crystal made a motion to approve, Suzanne seconded. Unanimous approval.

The Treasurer's report was given by Kim Betts – account balance was reviewed – Melissa made a motion to approve, Suzanne seconded. Unanimous approval

Funding Requests: AC movie license renewal (Amy Ruhland), Crystal made a motion to approve and Toni seconded – unanimous approval.

Old Business:

The donation to Boys and Girls Club T2 is completed. Jessica Davis will deliver the stadium seats to the Boys and Girls Club in Adair.

Shed: Trish does have blueprints. It's going to be cream corrugated metal to match the other buildings down there. No window, light will be hung up -12x12. This shed is for Booster Club use only, not shared. Ready to start this spring. Trish will go to board meeting on 3/21 for final approval.

New Business:

Track Season and getting concession stand ready – Sunday April 3rd is cleanup day at 1pm (***This was rescheduled to Sunday April 10th due to repairs being done on the water heater in the concession stand). We will marinate pork loins on Friday March 25 at 5pm and regroup on Sunday March 27 at 1pm for loin wrapping at the high school cafeteria.

The Booster Club will purchase 2 new roasters and 1 crockpot for the concession stand. Crystal moved to approve this purchase; Jessica gave the 2nd to the motion – Unanimous approval. Kim will purchase both.

Tricia informed the group that Sue Bump (ReShape in Panora) has spin exercise bikes for sale for \$300 each. ReShape is upgrading their current equipment and these were offered to the Booster Club to be added to the weight room. Club members discussed the different uses for this equipment including athlete rehab, strength and conditioning / PE classes as well as general public use. Crystal made a motion to purchase 4 bikes, Suzanne second – unanimous approval.
