Bond Measure X Annual Report

Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2022

Purpose:

Annual Report, required by the California Constitution governing the Measure X Bond Funds, is an overview of the oversight provided by the Citizens Oversight Committee. This report will provide a brief overview of the committee's objectives and areas of focus for the fiscal year July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022, as well as potential areas of focus for the future fiscal year. Objective:

The Citizen's Oversight Committee's (COC) primary responsibility is the review of expenditures of Measure X Bond funds to ensure they are being made in accordance with the Bond Language and the subsequent reporting to the citizens of Durham. These funds are for repairing and replacing deteriorating electrical, plumbing and sewer systems; upgrading agricultural and vocational teaching facilities; repairing leaky roofs; and renovating classrooms, restrooms and school facilities. The COC provides a valuable service for the residents of Durham in providing insight and assurance that the funds are being spent properly.

District Progress and Oversight Committee Activities:

The report of the Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC) represents the Measure X bond activity for the 2021-2022 fiscal year. The report is designed to correlate with the timelines of the voters' approved Measure X granting DUSD 19.7 million dollars of bond expenditure authority. Independent Auditors Audit Report:




