CSU—California State University

UC—University of California

CP—College Preparatory

Students must earn no lower than a "C" in each semester of each college preparatory (CP) course in order to use it for eligibility.

AP: Advanced Placement. These high school courses are taught at the equivalency and/or are comparable to a first-year college level course. AP courses prepare students to take AP Exams, which offer the opportunity to earn college credit while in high school.

College Entrance Exam Requirements: SAT and/or ACT exams are required in addition to completing the minimum requirements for eligibility.

GPA Minimum Requirements:

CSU – 2.75 GPA UC – 3.0 GPA

<u>IMPORTANT:</u> Eleven of fifteen A-G courses must be completed by Junior year for full review of college application to UC/CSU
