The Barneveld administrative team includes the District Administrator and the Principal(s). The team is the official, designated leadership unit for development, recommending, implementing, and monitoring board policy and administrative procedures.

The overall mission of the administrative team is to facilitate progress toward the Barneveld School District's education goals. The specific administrative functions include but are not limited to the following:

1. Determine priorities and direction for the school system
2. Making decisions - decide what strategies will be used to reach objectives; resolve problem areas: and plan/implement staff development.
3. Exercise leadership - motivate and work with staff.
4. Assemble and allocate resources within the established budgetary guidelines.
5. Control and monitor operations - determine how well the school system is moving toward its goals, managing facilities, supervising staff and services.
6. Appraise the performance of staff, the quality of services, products, or other outcomes.
7. Process information - gathering, maintaining, interpreting, and reporting information about all aspects of the school system.
8. Continue to improve the image of the school system.
9. Any other goals and directives as assigned by the school board.
