GUIDANCE PROGRAM

The Barneveld School District shall offer guidance services to all students. These services shall be based on recommendations from the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) with regard both to contemporary developmental guidance models and to school district needs and priorities. The focus of the program shall reflect a balance among three major areas of student development: learning/cognitive skills, personal/social skills and career/vocational skills.

The guidance program shall demonstrate an understanding of and a respect for the developmental competencies and challenges that students face as they grow and mature through their school-age years. The program of guidance services shall be administered as a part of the pupil services department.
