PHYSICAL EDUCATION CREDIT OPTION

In lieu of one-half credit of physical education for purposes of high school graduation a student who meets all of the following requirements shall be eligible to complete an additional one-half credit, in English, Social Studies, Math, Science or Health Education. A student is eligible for this option under the following conditions:

- a. The student must complete two full seasons of participating in at least one WIAA sanctioned J.V., Varsity, or other district sponsored sport before credit is granted.
- b. The student must be actively involved in a sport the year the exemption is granted.
- c. The student is a junior or a senior.
- d. A student with a disability, who is not able to meet the requirements for participation in any of the school's WIAA sports programs due to his/her disability, but who has participated in another organized physical activity approved by the Principal, may also be eligible for this physical education credit option.
- e. The student must be in good standing on the team(s) for the entire length of the season and had no athletic code violations.
- f. Second semester seniors cannot use this waiver/option.
