GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

For a student to graduate from Barneveld High School, the student must meet both of the minimum requirements specified in numbers 1 and 2 below. A student will receive a signed diploma only at such time as he or she has satisfied all requirements for graduation and all debts, fines, detentions, etc. Only a student who is eligible to receive a diploma may participate in the Barneveld School District’s graduation ceremonies.

Graduation Requirements:

- 1. The student will have attended four full academic years of high school. While attending Barneveld High School, each student will follow the guidelines outlined in the course description guide, unless other arrangements have been approved by the high school principal.
- 2. The student must successfully earn 28 credits of study. The 28 credits must include:

American History 9 (1 credit) required

One credit must be taken during the 11 th and/or 12 th grade

TOTAL CREDITS: 28

Note: Personal Finance can count as a business credit (if taught by a certified Business Ed teacher) or a Math credit (if taught by a certified Math teacher). It cannot count for both.

Student with Special Education Requirements

1. Individualized educational programs (IEP) for high school graduation may be provided to accommodate students with special education requirements under established conditions. The program will:
 - a. State the specific nature of the student’s special education requirements;
 - b. State how the proposed program will respond to the student’s special education needs;
 - c. State how the educational program will address each of the district’s graduation requirements.
2. A student with Special Education Needs, as determined by an IEP team, must meet the requirements outlined in their IEP’s in order to graduate from high school. The IEP team will determine if progress toward the goals warrant graduation.
3. A student with a 504 Plan in place will have accommodations provided, as documented in his or her 504 plan to assist him or her in meeting graduation requirements.
4. Successful completion of an education program under (1) or (2) above will result in issuance of a diploma.
