

**Barneveld School District
Summer School Attendance Policy**

The Barneveld School District understands that during the summer student attendance in summer school activities may be interrupted by family vacations and/or other non-school activities. For the purpose of reporting attendance to DPI in summer school classes, we establish the following attendance policy:

A student shall be reported as in full attendance when that student has attended half or more days of a class in a non-required summer school class that lasts four or more days. Absence of more than half the days in a class four or more days shall be counted according to DPI guidelines that determine Average Daily Membership. For classes of three days or less Average Daily Membership shall also be used if a student is gone one or two days. For all remedial middle school, any absences must be approved by the supervising teacher, and all assignments must be made up in subsequent sessions. Attendance shall be recorded by logged minutes.
