STUDENT ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

The Barneveld School Board recognizes their responsibility to provide non-discriminatory testing for all students. The assessment instruments used during the evaluation shall be appropriately adapted for a student's special needs whenever appropriate.

The tests and similar evaluation materials shall be administered in the child's primary language wherever appropriate. If necessary, interpreters may be used throughout the evaluation.

Supervision of the Special Education evaluation shall include monitoring of evaluations to ensure that they are non-discriminatory and that placement in special education is based on data broader than a single intelligence score or evaluation instrument.

The Barneveld School District will use the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction's recommended Guidelines for Testing of Limited English Proficient (LEP) Students.

The Barneveld School District does not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color, religion, creed, age, national origin, ancestry, pregnancy, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity or disability.
