

BARNEVELD SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT SOLICITATIONS

Materials which are essentially in the nature of advertising or solicitation shall not be distributed in the school to the pupils. Materials that are essentially educational in content or which bear directly upon educational purposes may be used or distributed in classes in spite of incidental advertising , or religious references with prior approval of the District Administrator.

Materials which are essentially religious in nature shall not be distributed in the school to the pupils.

The distribution of any written or tangible item to or the solicitation of any student on properties owned or controlled by the Barneveld School District shall be done only with prior approval of the District Administrator.

SOLICITATIONS BY STUDENTS

Pupils may not be used by district personnel, for the following purposes:

1. For the promotion of the political purposes of the district. Political purposes shall be construed as positions taken by the district for the reason of influencing the electorate.
2. For the promotion of the political purposes of the Barneveld Education Association (BEA). Political purposes shall be construed as positions taken by the Association for the reason of influencing the electorate for the benefit of the Association or any of its members.
3. For the promotion of beliefs which would be in opposition to the First Amendment: Religious Freedom, Establishment Clause of the United States Constitution.
4. For the promotion of programs which are of a commercial nature, where the primary benefit would be personal profit.

This policy is not meant to limit Barneveld School Board activities in promoting other public causes which are deemed by it to be in the public interest and not in violation of the above restrictions.
