STUDENT INSTRUCTION DURING EXTENDED SCHOOL CLOSING

In the event of Barneveld School closing for 15 consecutive school days or longer due to health or any other factor, the administration is expected to have teachers send student lessons to their home on a regular basis in the mail, electronically, the internet, cell phone, telephone, distance learning, etc. Specifically, they could include: hard copy packets, online materials, email, web conferencing, podcasts, virtual classrooms, and phone conferencing, texting, etc. Students will be expected to complete their work, in a reasonable timeframe, and will be graded accordingly.

In cases where the building can not be used, but students/teachers can gather, alternate classrooms at available buildings, including churches, will be used within or outside of the district.
