STUDENT ALCOHOL AND DRUG USE

No student shall possess, distribute, sell or be under the influence of any unauthorized prescription drugs/medications, illegal drug or intoxicant while on the school premises, on the school bus, or while involved in any school sponsored activity. Students attending Barneveld School in violation of this policy shall be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with school regulations.

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education to take action through education, parental involvement, and police referral in the handling of incidents in the school involving the possession, sale, and/or use of any illegal drug or intoxicant. The Board and administration reserve the right to suspend or expel any student found in violation of the policy.

A student may be required to submit to a breath test to determine the presence of alcohol if a designated school official or law enforcement officer has reasonable suspicion that the student is under the influence of alcohol and in violation of this policy. Such test shall be administered by a law enforcement office and shall meet state law requirements. A student may be disciplined for refusing to submit to a breath test.
