

**BARNEVELD SCHOOL DISTRICT  
SUPERVISION OF STUDENTS**

The Barneveld School Board expects all students to be under assigned, adult supervision whenever a student is in school, on school grounds during school hours, participating in a school sponsored activity, or when traveling to and from a school sponsored activity.

The Barneveld School Board recognizes the need and importance of chaperones to assist district staff in the supervision of students during school-sponsored activities. Persons assigned supervisory responsibilities are expected to act as reasonably prudent adults when providing for the safety of the students under their supervision. No person shall leave his/her assigned group unsupervised unless reasonable and prudent arrangements are made.

During school hours or while participating in school-sponsored activities, students shall be released only to their parent or pursuant to pre-approved procedures that require written permission from the parent/guardian.
