STUDENT DISCIPLINE

Poor student behavior shall not be tolerated. If a student needs to be removed from school, it is the parent's responsibility to pick up their child.

The district principal and every teacher in the Barneveld School District shall insure that proper conduct and behavior is maintained by students in the classrooms, on school premises, on school buses and during school-sponsored activities. When teachers or staff members are unable to adequately handle a behavior situation or when ordinary methods of correction are ineffective, he/she should contact the principal for assistance and further action.

All information concerning a student or their families' background should be held in the strictest confidence consistent with legal requirements.

The school student handbook shall contain rules and regulations concerning proper student behavior, created by the administration and approved by the Barneveld School Board. These rules and regulations, along with state laws relating to student conduct and behavior, shall be distributed to students.

The Barneveld School District does not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color, religion, creed, age, national origin, ancestry, pregnancy, marital status, sexual orientation, or disability.
