FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT

Barneveld School District students shall have an opportunity to participate in the National School Lunch Program. This program shall be administered by the District Administrator guidelines.

As required for participation in the National School Lunch Program, the school district agrees to the following:

1. that a school lunch meeting federal regulations be made available for all students; and
2. that free and reduced price lunches be offered to eligible students who apply and who meet the federal income guideline.
3. In accordance with the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) any employee of the Barneveld School District will be forbidden from disclosing any data involving free and reduced lunch information of any student internally or externally.

Food service prices shall be established by the Barneveld School Board at the Annual Meeting.

Vending machines may be installed in the Barneveld School and may be in service during the noon hour only when the vending machines are a component of the a la carte food offerings. The vending machines must be non-functional during the lunch hour when not under the control of the food service program.

The Barneveld School District shall not discriminate in school-sponsored food service programs on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability, or any Federal or State law that subsequently is adopted. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
