Thank you for signing up to take the Fall PSAT/NMSQT on Wednesday, October 12th.

Please have your student here by 7am and have them report to the athletic hallway to check in.

If your student/child has accommodations then they will report to the Media Center for Audio or extended time. There will be a separatedown email from Mrs. Testorelli if your student/child qualifies for that.

The PSAT/NMSQT is approximately 3 and a half hours long plus there will be some preadministration questions they will need to fill out.

Please get a good amount of sleep and eat breakfast. Their exam should be done at approximately 11:30am. Please have their ride here by 11:30 if they are a remote or ECA student. Students who are in person at BHS will go to C lunch and then go to their 5th hour and 6th hour.

Important things to know for the day.

- 1. Backpacks and cell phones will not be permitted in the testing room (Main Gym). We will be collecting all cell phones/backpacks prior to letting them into the testing area.
- 2. Students can bring a water bottle but must be set on the floor.
- 3. We encourage students to bring snacks that fit in their pockets.
- 4. We encourage students to bring their own calculator and #2 pencils. We will have some here as well.
- 5. Students will be sitting at 6 foot tables with appropriate spacing.

The PSAT/NMSQT test is extremely important as it evaluates your skills concerning college and career readiness. Based on the skills you demonstrate on the PSAT/NMSQT, you will receive

feedback on how to build upon your strengths and improve your areas of weakness. You will also receive a report that shows your growth from the fall, and offers guidance in educational goals and career planning.

Please do your best on this test as the results are treated very seriously and will be used to guide your future.
