

Driving privileges can be revoked for any of the following offenses:

- 1. Excessive <u>tardiness and absences</u> during a semester.
- 2. Speeding (posted speed limit 10 miles/hour), reckless and negligent driving on school property.
- 3. Using or allowing your vehicle to be used for illegal purposes, i.e. smoking, drinking and loitering.
- 4. Parking in an unauthorized area (staff parking, parking lot in front of school, Early Childhood Center).
- 5. Going to your car without a pass from the main office.
- 6. Failure to register your vehicle, improper display or use of school permit.
- 7. Using vehicle to leave school without permission.
- 8. Failure to follow published parking lot rules and procedures.
- 9. Excessively loud noise.
- 10. Violations of the Student Code of Conduct



Parking Permits



Students driving to Belleville High School must have a current student-parking permit. Permits must be visible on your **FRONT** windshield.

Priority for parking permits will be given to students according to the following criteria:

- 1. Student is enrolled in the Co-op Program.
- 2. Student is involved in athletics or after school activities.
- Student is a senior.
- 4. Student is a junior.
- 5. Student is a sophomore.
- 6. Daily permits may be purchased on a limited basis for \$1.00 a day.

We reserve the right to bar any automobile/driver from the parking lot, which we consider to be a menace to the safety of others. All vehicles are subject to inspection and search for reasonable cause.

Parking at the high school is at your own risk. BHS is NOT responsible for vandalism or damage to cars and property so please do the following:

- Report vandalism and other concerns to the parking attendant/office.
- Lock your vehicle, turn off lights, park between lines, and use trash cans for litter.

NOTE: Return completed form to the secretary in the office. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.

- STUDENT PARKING: Parking area for ALL STUDENTS is located on the East end of BHS near the football field. All students must park in their assigned space and enter the parking lot via W. Columbia Ave.
- No student parking in staff areas, front parking lot, Early Childhood Center or at the Administration Building.




