Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Savage Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

Savage Elementary School has continued to work on improving our English Language Arts (ELA) and Math scores with Math being our lowest area. We use Everyday Math and have incorporated Number Talks and Math Tasks to help improve our scores. We are currently using iReady as our state approved assessment tool and we continue to monitor our scores utilizing our data wall and weekly grade level meetings. In our meetings we will adjust instruction based upon our data in order to better meet the students' needs whether that be for support or to challenge and advance our students.

ASSIGNING PUPILS TO OUR SCHOOL

The Board of Education determines the school attendance area of the district and requires the students within each area to attend their homeschool. SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN PROGRESS

A major focus of the school improvement plan is increasing student achievement in all content areas; especially in the area of mathematics and literacy. A driving force for our school improvement plan is using data from iReady, Common Unit Assessments and DRA scores. This data is analyzed weekly and monthly in our grade level meetings to assist us in providing instruction that meets the needs of the students and our school improvement goals. We have implemented Project Lead the Way for our Science curriculum. Our teacher leaders have been trained and are coaches for the classroom teachers. Staff development is an integral component of the ongoing school improvement process.

DESCRIPTION OF SPECIALIZED SCHOOL

Savage Road Elementary School is very proud to house the Gifted and Talented program for the Van Buren School district and we currently have 93 students enrolled.

CURRICULUM ACCESS

The school follows the state curriculum of the Michigan Common Core State Standards.
