Parents:

I am writing this letter to inform you of a couple of small issues that I/we are needing to address as we start the second semester of school.

First, is the issue of tardiness to class. Tardiness interferes with the instructional process, which is a detriment to not only the student who is tardy, but also to the other students in class, as the teacher has to stop instruction to deal with the tardy infraction. Remember our students are expected to be in class with all necessary materials when the tardy bell rings. Being more than 15 minutes late to class will result in an absence. Tardies will accumulate for the entire semester. On the third tardy in any one class, the teacher will issue a verbal warning and will document the warning. On the fourth tardy the student will be sent to administration, and an after school detention will be issued from 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Further infractions will result in punishment to be determined by the administration.

Next, we are having a small issue with the wearing of our student I.D. badges. Please remember that these badges are used for scanning lunches, scanning library books, but most importantly for safety concerns. We want to make sure that our students are identifiable in the event an outside agency (police, sheriff, fire) should need to enter the building. These badges help with that issue and help us to identify quickly at a glance if someone is in the building that does not belong. This is a non negotiable situation. The result in not wearing your badge will also result in an after school detention from 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

After school detention will be held on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday afternoons. Parental contact will be made if a detention is issued. The school will not provide transportation for those students on days that they serve detention. A parent or guardian will have to come pick up their students on those days.

This policy will go into effect starting Monday, January 14, 2019.
