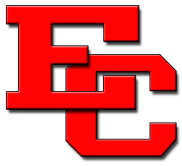

Use of Funds

- 1. The extent to which and how the funds will be used to implement prevention and mitigation strategies that are to the greatest extent practicable, consistent with the most recent CDC guidance on reopening schools, in order to continuously and safely open and operate schools for in-person learning.*

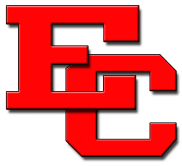
Activity	Purpose
Water Bottle Dispensers	Reduce surface touching; reduce spread of contamination
McLemore Cleaning	Cleaning and sanitizing services to reduce the spread of COVID-19
School Bus	Spread students out on routes to reduce COVID-19
Student Bus Tracking	Students spread out on buses to reduce COVID-19; possible creation of additional routes; ability to track when students are on / off bus
Auto Flush Toilets	Reduce surface touching; reduce spread of contamination
Automatic Faucets	Reduce surface touching; reduce spread of contamination
HVAC Systems	Improve air quality and reduce the spread of COVID-19
Cafeteria Seating	Increase space between students
Keyless Entry	Reduce surface touching; reduce spread of contamination

2. *To address the academic impact of lost instructional time through the implementation of evidence-based interventions, such as summer learning or summer enrichment, extended day, comprehensive after school programs, or extended school year. Also, ensure that interventions implemented will respond to the academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of all students, and particularly those students disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, including students from low-income families, students of color, English learners, children with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, children in foster care, and migratory students.*
