Work to Improve Grades: Within each three-week progress reporting period, teachers will provide students with an opportunity to re-learn and reassess the TEKS/curriculum. For each assignment and assessment, teachers will re-teach and allow students an opportunity to show mastery of taught objectives. The highest possible grade that can be earned and recorded on the reassessment is a 70. The teacher will make a note in the gradebook of the dates and grades of the re-teach/reassessment. To take advantage of this opportunity, it is the student's responsibility to initiate a process with his/her teacher for reteaching and reassessment of the assignment or test. The following assessments are not subject to the reassessment guidelines: 9 weeks tests, semester exams, performance assessments, student projects, and benchmark tests.

Beginning in 19-20 school year students enrolled in Advanced & Advanced Placement (AP) courses are not eligible to reassess minor grades.
