



## School Safety Transfers Overview El Campo ISD

<b>Class Changes</b>	The campus principal shall be authorized to investigate and approve the transfer of a student from one classroom to another. <i>FDB(LOCAL)</i>
<b>Students Who Are Victims of Bullying</b>	One the request of the parent or another person with authority to act on behalf of a student who is a victim of bullying, the board or its designee shall transfer the victim to another classroom at the campus to which the victim was assigned at the time the bullying occurred. <i>FDB(LEGAL)</i>
<b>Students Who Engage in Bullying</b>	The board may transfer the student who engaged in bullying to another other classroom at the campus to which the victim was assigned at the time the bullying occurred. <i>FDB(LEGAL)</i>
<b>From a Persistently Dangerous School</b>	The parent of a student attending a school identified as persistently dangerous shall be provided notification of his or her right to request a transfer. Notification shall occur at least 14 days prior to the start of the school year or, for a student enrolling subsequently, upon the student's enrollment. <i>FDE(LOCAL)</i>
<b>For a Victim of a Violent Criminal Offense</b>	Within 14 calendar days after a violent criminal offense occurs in or on the premises of the school the student attends or while attending a school-sponsored or school-related activity, on or off school property, the District shall notify the parent of a student who is a victim of the offense of the parent's right to request a transfer. The parent must submit to the Superintendent an application for transfer. The Superintendent shall approve or disapprove the request within 14 calendar days of its submission. <i>FDE(LOCAL)</i>
<b>Additional Transfer Options</b>	In circumstances described by Education Code 25.0341, a parent of a student who has been the victim of a sexual assault, regardless of whether the offense occurred on or off school property, may request a transfer of the parent's child or the student assailant from the same campus. <i>FDE(LOCAL)</i>
