

## **School Safety Transfers Overview** El Campo ISD

Class Changes

The campus principal shall be authorized to investigate and approve the transfer of a student from one classroom to another. FDB(LOCAL)

Students Who Are Victims of Bullying

One the request of the parent or another person with authority to act on behalf of a student who is a victim of bullying, the board or its designee shall transfer the victim to another classroom at the campus to which the victim was assigned at the time the bullying occured. FDB(LEGAL)

**Students Who Engage in Bullying** 

The board may transfer the student who engaged in bullying to another other classroom at the campus to which the victim was assigned at the time the bullying occurred. FDB(LEGAL)

**Dangerous School** 

From a Persistently The parent of a student attending a school identified as persistently dangerous shall be provided notification of his or her right to request a transfer. Notification shall occur at least 14 days prior to the start of the school year or, for a student enrolling subsequently, upon the student's enrollment. FDE(LOCAL)

For a Victim of a **Violent Criminal** Offense

Within 14 calendar days after a violent criminal offense occurs in or on the premises of the school the student attends or while attending a school-sponsored or school-related activity, on or off school property, the District shall notify the parent of a student who is a victim of the offense of the parent's right to request a transfer. The parent must submit to the Superintendent an application for transfer. The Superintendent shall approve or disapprove the request within 14 calendar days of its submission. FDE(LOCAL)

**Options** 

Additional Transfer In circumstances described by Education Code 25.0341, a parent of a student who has been the victim of a sexual assault, regardless of whether the offense occurred on or off school property, may request a transfer of the parent's child or the student assailant from the same campus. FDE(LOCAL)
