

It is the policy of Cassia County Joint School District No. 151 that for grades kindergarten (K) through five (5), students' progress and achievement will be reported on a scale of one (1) to three (3) in the separate areas of development with the numbers giving the following value:

1. Below Basic – Below grade level/classroom standards
2. Basic – Near grade level/classroom standards
3. Proficient – Meets grade level/classroom standards

For grades six (6) through twelve (12), students' progress and achievement shall be reported on the basis of the letter grades A- Superior; B-Above Average, Good; C-Average; D-Below Average, Poor; F-Failure.

The letter grades interpreted shall have the following numerical values:

Plus and minus signs will be used on permanent records. Incomplete grades are to be made up by the end of the next succeeding grading period except by special arrangement or as requested by the teacher.

Grades granted for partial credit courses at the secondary level will not be computed for purposes of determining membership in honor groups or organizations, or class rank class.
