<u>Title:</u> <u>High School Coursework Taken in Middle School</u>

## **Transcript and Credit**

The St. Croix Central School District will be following selected DPI recommendations stated in Act 138, 2013. The District will apply the following guidelines pertaining to transcript and credit(s) awarded:

- 1. All courses must be taught by a high school certified instructor.
- 2. The course will be noted on the transcript.
- 3. The assigned grade will appear on the transcript.
- 4. Full credit will be awarded in the appropriate content area (i.e. math, science...).
- 5. Credit earned will be counted toward graduation requirements.

# Retaking a Course, Replacing a Letter Grade, and Grade Point Average

The following principles will apply to students taking High School Coursework prior to enrolling in the high school:

- 1. Students will be allowed to retake a course to improve their grade.
- 2. The letter grade will be factored into the overall grade point average.
  - a. If the student retakes the course, the higher grade will be factored into the overall grade point average.
  - b. For tracking purposes, both courses will be listed on the transcript.

### **Core Content Courses**

This policy will only apply to core content courses. All students must complete the following requirements regardless of how many credits they've earned prior to enrolling in high school.

- Math: 3 years (6 semesters) of math in grade 9-12.
- English: 4 years (8 semesters) of English in grade 9-12.
- Science: 3 years (6 semesters) of science in grade 9-12.
- Social Studies: 3 years (6 semesters) of social studies in grade 9-12.

#### **Elective Content Courses**

Courses taken in an elective content area will be considered on an individual basis and will require pre-approval from school administration.

### **Online Coursework**

Courses may be taken at the high school, middle school, or through Wisconsin Virtual School (WVS) with a high school certified instructor. Other options will be accepted as deemed appropriate by school administration.
