

1. Child Nutrition Maintenance Personnel.

- a. Qualifications. The Maintenance Personnel shall be of good moral character, preferably with experience related to the position. The person shall hold at least a high school diploma; and additional training will be valuable and preferred.
- b. Duties/Responsibilities. The Maintenance Personnel will be directly supervised by the Child Nutrition Director and/or local school Principal and shall perform the following primary duties:
- (1) To perform all minor repairs and maintenance work as rapidly and as efficiently as possible in all school cafeterias in the District.
 - (2) To recommend the purchase of such equipment, supplies and materials necessary for proper maintenance of school cafeterias.
 - (3) To maintain proper inventory of and distribution of maintenance equipment, supplies and materials to the respective school cafeterias.
 - (4) To perform such other reasonable duties assigned by the Child Nutrition Director.
 - (5) Assist in developing preventative and corrective maintenance on all equipment.
 - (6) Makes repairs regarding plumbing, electrical, mechanical and carpentry to all cafeterias.
 - (7) Install new equipment as need.
 - (8) Have the ability to lift and carry at least 75 lbs.
 - (9) Adhere to district policies, safety regulations and OSHA requirements.
 - (10) Analyze repair requests and troubleshooting.
 - (11) Working knowledge or ability to learn regarding refrigeration equipment.
