Daily Symptom Monitoring and When to Stay Home from School

Each day prior to attending school or work, please self-assess for the following symptoms:

Fever (100°F or higher) Chills Cough Shortness of breath or difficulty breath- ing Fatigue Muscle or body aches	Headache New loss of taste or smell Sore throat Congestion or runny nose Nausea or vomiting Diarrhea
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Anyone with a fever ($\geq 100^{\circ}$ F) or feels feverish should STAY HOME until their fever has resolved for at least 24 hours without the use of medication and test for COVID-19.

Attending School with MILD Respiratory Symptoms

If **MILD** Respiratory Symptoms (infrequent cough, mild congestion, runny nose, mild sore throat ONLY) are present with **NO FEVER** and **NO KNOWN COVID-19** case in your household – you may attend school if you self-test for COVID-19 prior to leaving for school every day you have symptoms.

-If test result is <u>negative</u>, you may attend in-person if well enough to participate

Repeat self-test each day until symptoms resolve (negative test results do not need to be submitted to school)

STRONGLY encouraged to wear a well-fitting mask indoors until symptoms resolve

-If test result is <u>positive</u>, **STAY HOME**

Report results to school

Complete isolation (see below)

Positive COVID-19 Test – Isolation

STAY HOME for at least 5 days

-If no symptoms – day 0 is the day you were tested

-If you have symptoms – day 0 is the day of symptom onset

Return on Day 6 -If fever free for at least 24 hours without use of medication, and symptoms are resolved or significantly improved.

CLEVER Portal

CLEVER Portal is an online learning platform for students. This portal allows parents a single sign on ID, where students are able to access all our digital learning resources.

-Click on Student log in

-All students have a CLEVER badge or sign in information from teachers
