I AM READY TO GO BACK WHEN I AM...

Fever free for 24 hours without use of fever reducing medicine (Tylenol, Ibuprofen, etc.)	Free from vomiting for at least 24 hours and had at least 2 solid meals	Free from diarrhea for at least 24 hours	Free from rash, itching, or fever for 24 hours or has been evaluated by a doctor if needed	Treated with appropriate lice treatment and no live lice present and evidence of egg/nit removed. The child will be checked by school staff upon return to school	Evaluated by a doctor and has a note to return to school. Has used eye medication for at least 24 hours	Released by my medical provider and note for OK to return to school
