Two (2) scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1,000 dollars each to two (2) graduating high school seniors from either Okaloosa, Santa Rosa, or Walton Counties who plan to continue with their music education at the college level (major or minor). APPLICATION/AUDITION PROCESSES

- 1. Complete attached **Scholarship Application Form.** If additional space is needed, attach separate sheets.
- 2. Submit a **Letter of Recommendation** from your high school choral or instrumental instructor, or a licensed and qualified music instructor.
- 3. Submit a **3-5 minute Video Performance**. Please use your **5 minute, max time limit, in this way:**Up to **2 minutes** covering the following elements and **3 minutes performing your music selection**.:
 - a. Introduce yourself.
 - b. State the school you currently attend
 - c. Explain how you became interested in and what excites you about music
 - d. Explain what you intend to do with music in the future
 - e. State the title of the selection you will be performing and what makes it significant.
- 4. Return the Completed Application along with Letter of Recommendation and Video Performance by email to fwbcc1975@gmail.com no later than April 7, 2023. No late applications will be accepted for any reason after due date.
- 5. Completed applications will be judged on talent, professional appearance, presentation, poise and enthusiasm via Video Performance.
- 6. Winners will be asked to perform at one (1) of our three (3) Spring Shows, May 12, 13, & 14, 2023. It is an excellent opportunity to give back to the Chorus and to our patrons who support us and our efforts to provide these scholarships each year.
