Volunteer Service Hours Information *(Taken from the Bright Futures Student Handbook)*

- Students may identify a social or civic issue or a professional area that interests them and develop a plan for their personal involvement in addressing the issue or learning about the area.
- The student **must**, through papers or presentations, evaluate and reflect upon their volunteer service experience.
- Such volunteer service may include, but not limited to, a business or governmental internship, nonprofit community service organization, or activities on behalf of a candidate for public office.
- The hours of volunteer service must be documented in writing, and the document must be signed by the student, the student's parent/guardian, and a representative of the organization for which the student performed the volunteer service.
- Students **cannot** combine volunteer service with paid work hours.
- Florida Academic Scholars (FAS) = 100 hours
- Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS) = 75 hours
- Florida Gold Seal Vocational Scholars (GSV) = 30 hours
- Students participating in the Home Education program, must provide documentation of hours and dates of service on agency letterhead
