## **Online Providers**

Please be aware of the following information when you sign up for an online class:

- It is no longer a graduation requirement to take an online course.
- Your counselor cannot register you for an online course. You must complete the registration process described below. Your counselor's role is only to approve your request.
- If you take Algebra 1, Geometry, US History, and/or Biology, you will still have to take a state EOC in order to complete the course grade and earn credit for the course. EOCs are given in December and May. It is your responsibility to find out when and where you will be testing.
- If you take an AP course from one of the online providers, it is your responsibility to set up your AP Central account, register for the test by the November deadline, and contact the Advanced Studies Coordinator about the date, time, and location of the test.
- When you take an online class, you are not taking the class at Niceville High School. Your Niceville
  High School counselor cannot unlock tests for you, help you with technical problems, communicate
  with your teacher, drop the course for you, etc. Niceville High School teachers cannot provide
  tutoring or study guides for you. For any assistance, you will need to contact the Online provider
  and/or your online instructor.
