(1) dependent* children of active, full-time Military Members who work 32 hours or more per week and have at least one year of service by the application deadline date or honorably discharged US Military Veterans at ASUS-served locations; and

2) High school seniors or graduates, or undergraduate students, who plan to enroll or are currently enrolled in a full-time** undergraduate course of study in technology, environmental science. environmental engineering, biology or chemistry, medical sciences, mathematical sciences. business acquisition management or and contract management at an accredited two-year or four-year college or a vocational-technical school.

Awards may be renewed for up to three additional years or until a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever occurs first. Renewal is contingent upon satisfactory academic performance in a full-time course of study (maintaining a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent). continued military employment of the student's parent (US Military veterans verification upon initial award only), continuation of the program by ASUS, Inc.

Awards are for undergraduate study only.
