

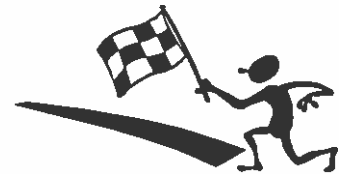

➤ HERE IS HOW TO ASSEMBLE YOUR LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

1. This year we will be using a brass brad – one hole punch to secure the documents. We are not using folders this year. We will supply the brass holder.
2. Make a cover page with your name and the name of the scholarship.
3. The next document should be an application if there is one for the scholarship. If not, go to next step,
4. If there is a unique essay required for a specific scholarship, put that next. If no unique essay is required, then put your personal essay here. Your personal essay is your story and why you should be considered the best candidate for the award. **BE SURE AND READ THE SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING ESSAYS.**
5. Put your letters of recommendation next. You need two. Teachers, coaches, counselors and employers are all good options for letters of recommendation.
6. Your high school transcript is next. Stop in the guidance office and ask Mrs. Keith, Mrs. Bloom or Dr. Spaid to print it for you.
7. The Financial Statement – page 13 of this packet

## **THESE ARE THE LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS:**

**This first section has applications... the forms are in the Career Center**

### **GERALD REED MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is for graduating seniors who have the rank of Eagle Scout, or have verified that their application for that rank has been received at the national B.S.A. office. Community service is an important part of this scholarship application. ***Application in the Career Center.***

### **CLEARFIELD COUNTY COUNSELORS' ASSOCIATION**

This scholarship will be presented to a student who is entering a helping profession such as teaching, counseling, health care etc. It will be awarded to a student from one of the member schools of this association. ***Application in Career Center.***

### **JUDY ROSENTHAL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a graduating senior with a 3.0 grade point average, who personifies integrity and character; who devotes time and effort to community based volunteer efforts and who has excelled in gymnastics, swimming, tennis, or cheerleading. ***Application in Career Center.***

### **GLADYS A. TOZIER SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is awarded on the basis of need, scholarship and character. The applicant must be a resident of Clearfield County. ***Application in Career Center. THIS ONE COMES IN LATER... Keep checking***



### **ELKS' NURSING SCHOLARSHIPS**

These scholarships are available to both female and male students with nursing as their expressed career goal. Although a scholarship winner can receive this award for a maximum of four years of education, the scholarships are not automatically renewable and are subject to cancellation. ***Application in Career Center. YOU MUST PROVIDE A COPY OF YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER INTO A REGISTERED NURSING PROGRAM.***

### **THE MARK MORGAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

The Mark Morgan Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior baseball player who has played baseball for at least 2 years. **Application in Career Center.**

### **WOMEN'S CLUB OF CLEARFIELD**

The Women's Club of Clearfield offers an award to a student pursuing some form of post-high school education. The club will consider need, character, and scholastic standing. There is an application and an essay to be completed.

### **CLEARFIELD HOSPITAL NURSES ALUMNI ASSOCIATION**

To be awarded to a student entering nursing training. The selection is made now, but actual presentation will be made after successful completion of the first year of schooling. **Details in Career Center. YOU MUST PROVIDE A COPY OF YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER INTO A REGISTERED NURSING PROGRAM.**

### **F. MICHAEL SICKS, POST 1785 VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS SCHOLARSHIP**

The student must have had a family member (father, mother, grandfather, grandmother) who is/was a veteran. Students attending any post high school education (college, university, technical or trade school) can apply. **Applications available in the Career Center.**

### **THE BRENDA CLAPSADLE THORNHILL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

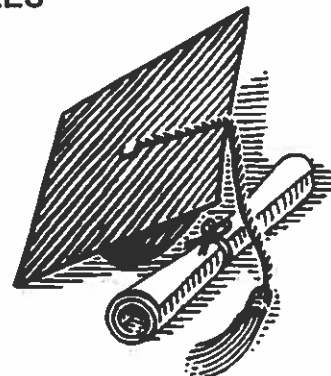
The Brenda Clapsadle Thornhill Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior girl who has been a two-year varsity letter winner in the sports of basketball, volleyball and/or softball while obtaining academic success. **Application in Career Center.**

### **THE LES EDMONDSON SCHOLARSHIP**

A scholarship for student athletes attending a 4 year or 2-year college or technical school. You must write an essay that describes how involvement in sports has positively affected your life or how a coach has positively affected your life. Essay must be typed in 12-point font- double spaced and be no more than 2 pages long. Essay should follow the KISS principle- Keep It Simple & Sincere. **Application for the Edmondson Scholarship available in the Career Center.**

### **THE CURWENSVILLE ALLIANCE CARLA AND LEVI ROWLES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is for students who are active in their church or youth group and who have a genuine interest in Christian Service. You must write a history of your work with your church/youth group and an essay explaining how the scholarship will be a blessing to you and a benefit for the Kingdom of God. **Application for the Rowles Scholarship available in the Career Center.**



### CLASS OF 1975 SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is for any student pursuing post-secondary education at a college, university or trade school. Criteria for selection include grades, GPA of 85% or better, community service and or extra-curricular involvement. This scholarship is not necessarily a financial need based scholarship. **Application in the Career Center.**

### DAVE AND HOLLIE WOODLE ASPIRING STRENGTH SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship will be awarded to a Clearfield Area High School senior who demonstrates excellence in scholastic achievement, community service, and leadership. Must be completed online. **Form is in the Career Center.**

### CLEARFIELD EDUCATION SUPPORT PROFESSIONALS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is for a student enrolled in a specialized business or nursing degree program. You must have a GPA of 85% and been involved in community activities and extra curricular activities and or employed. **Application in Career Center.**

### LION'S REPRESENTATIVE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Award available to a male or female student planning to attend any form of post-high school training. Club considers scholarship, leadership, volunteerism and financial need. **Application can be picked up in the Career Center.**



### KENNETH MCMILLEN SWIMMING SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is for seniors who are on the swim team and the criteria is GPA, community activities as well as extra-curricular activities. **Application can be picked up in the Career Center.**

### ADRIENNE STUCKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a senior who from grades 9-12 has won two varsity letters in volleyball, and/or who has participated in any one musical organization. **Application can be picked up in the Career Center.**

### CNB BANK SCHOLARSHIP

CNB Bank encourages community service and academic excellence. The applicant is expected to maintain a good GPA and play an active role in school and /or community activities. The applicant should also be pursuing a business degree. The essay will be judged on the criteria established each year. New application and essay topic are received every year. Dependents of officers and directors of CNB Bank are not eligible for the scholarship. **Application can be picked up in the Career Center.**

### THE SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF ITALY Lodge 189 Scholarship

Seniors must be attending a 2 or 4-year college, and must complete 2 essays. Financial need, grades and essay content will be used as criteria for awarding the scholarship. **Application can be picked up in the Career Center**

### **JANET MCCRACKEN HANSARD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

The criteria for this scholarship is volunteer service and pursuing a degree in social work. If no social work candidate applies, a candidate pursuing related helping profession majors may apply. Open to all area schools. **Application available in the Career Center**

### **CLEARFIELD BPW**

The scholarship will be awarded to a senior student, or an adult returning to college, at the discretion of the club. Financial need, grades, and community service will be considered. **Application can be picked up in the Career Center.**

### **CLEARFIELD BPW – PAULA READ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is for any senior who is entering the field of education. Student must be enrolled in a bachelor degree program for teaching- either elementary or secondary. Financial need, grades, and community service will be considered. **Application available in the Career Center.**

### **CLEARFIELD EDUCATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP**

Applicant must be the son or daughter of a present, retired, or deceased CEA member attending any high school and graduating this year. Stepchildren residing with CEA members are also eligible. Applicant must be accepted to a program of higher education that requires 2 or more years of study. Awards will be determined on the basis of grade point average, difficulty of courses, class rank, SAT/ACT scores, essay, and current resume. **Application in the Career Center.**

### **CLEARFIELD ARTS STUDIO THEATRE SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is for students who have been involved in the performing arts in some manner. A resume and essay detailing how the arts have influenced you are required. **Application in the Career Center.**

### **TOM TURNER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is for a CHS Senior attending a technical or vocational trade school in the fall semester. There is an essay required describing why you want to enter the field you will be pursuing. **Application in the Career Center.**

### **FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES # 812**

#### **HAROLD "BUCKEY" SMEAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Must be a graduating senior, attending the Clearfield Area School District and plan to attend, or currently attend an accredited college or university on a full time basis. Must have acquired acceptance to, or be enrolled at the college of his/her choice and must be an enrolled full-time student for the fall semester of their graduation year. Must provide proof of acceptance and/or enrollment in the college of his/her choice before monies will be paid in the student's name.

### **LEANNA MARIE SHUGARTS SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded by the Clearfield Soccer Association. Will be awarded to a male and female soccer player. Applicant must have played 3 or more seasons in the Clearfield Soccer Association. Scholarship will be awarded based on participation in soccer, community service, and character.

### **MIKE AUMAN SOCCER SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is in honor of Mr. Mike Auman, a revered soccer coach in the Clearfield area who passed away. One scholarship will be awarded to a male and one to a female player. A comprehensive essay detailing your background in soccer is required along with your personal essay. In the comprehensive essay, include the following information: 1) Must have played on the high school soccer team for 4 years; 2) Intention to play soccer in college at collegiate or intermural level; 3) volunteered with soccer association in some manner; 4) Participated in Soccer clinics; 5) Played soccer in some other league as well as high school.

### **JUDD ZIMMER SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is in honor of Judd Zimmer, a past Clearfield Borough Police Chief. Community service is the main component of this award. You must be enrolled in either the field of criminology or forensics. An essay describing why you are interested in this field must be included.

### **ELK HOSE COMPANY ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP**

Awarded to a graduating senior who plans to pursue a degree in the Public Safety and Security or Health Services fields. The Association will consider degree choice, scholastic achievement and need.

### **EDITH BROWN HASTINGS NURSING SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is for students entering the profession of nursing and is need based. Please write a short essay explaining why you are pursuing a career in nursing. ***YOU MUST PROVIDE A COPY OF YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER INTO A REGISTERED NURSING PROGRAM.***

### **THE DR. STEVEN C. PENNINGTON MEMORIAL AWARD**

The recipient must be kind, out-going and social-as well as be in an academic course of study and committed to entering the Chiropractic/Healthcare/Social Services Field.

### **FULLINGTON AUTO BUS COMPANY SERVICE AWARD**

Presented in memory of Mrs. Mildred F. Fullington former co-owner of the Fullington Auto Bus Company. Awarded to two graduating students who plan to continue their education at a college, university or technical/trade school. Criteria include the following: grade point average of 3.0 or higher, sound attendance record and active in two or more school extracurricular activities with one being related to the arts or athletics, commitment to active community service (civic, church, scouting or school volunteer associations).

### **CHARLES VOGELSONG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP TRUST**

Award in memory of former Clearfield School District Assistant Superintendent. Award given to a male or female student planning to attend any form of post-high school college program. Copies of parents' tax returns must be supplied. Award based upon need, scholarship and good citizenship.



### **CLEARFIELD BISON ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP**

Local scholarship awarded to a male or female student planning to attend any form of post-high school college training. The organization will consider need, scholarship and citizenship.

### **CLASS OF 1962 SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is for any student pursuing post-secondary education at a college, university or trade school. Criteria for selection include grades, GPA, community service and financial need.

### **ROBERT L LUMADUE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Robert (Bob) Lumadue graduated from Clearfield High School in 1967. After graduating he obtained a degree in Biology from the University of Massachusetts. Following six years as an Army officer, Bob began his lifelong defense of our precious natural resources. He served for nearly a decade as a Conservation Officer for the Pennsylvania Game Commission before moving on to his final career as a Special Agent for the US Fish and Wildlife Service.

In Bob's honor and memory, this scholarship is available to a Clearfield High School Senior who is planning to pursue a baccalaureate degree focused on preserving, protecting or enhancing our natural world.

Please submit an essay of 500 words or less describing how your educational and career goals make you the best candidate for this scholarship.

### **ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**

The Rotary Club of Clearfield offers a scholarship that is awarded to a student going on to a post-high school education at an accredited institution. Applicants need to stress community service because priority will be given to those activities in the selection process.



### **THE FRED DIEHL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSIP**

This scholarship is awarded to the senior student(s) who have a genuine love of the outdoors. Student must have a GPA of 3.0, have a strong academic record and be involved in his or her community. Preference will be given to students majoring in environmental fields. Applicants must be enrolled in a 2 or 4-year program of study.

### **MARSHA NOVEY MEMORIAL SWIMMING SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating Senior on the swim team. The student must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA and must participate in some form of community service. The recipient must exemplify great character as a team player in the sport and in the community. The scholarship is for a student enrolled in a 4 year or 2-year program of study.

### **THE CUNNINGHAM SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is for a male and female student who has won a citizenship award their junior year. The students must be pursuing post secondary education on a full time basis. Students must provide a one page essay that details a recent compassionate act in relationship to another person.

### **THE ART WEISS SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship will be awarded to a high school wrestler who has lettered at least once in wrestling and plans to wrestle in college.

### **THE MARIE SPINGOLA MAINES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship will be awarded to a female senior. The criteria for selection of the recipient in order of importance is:

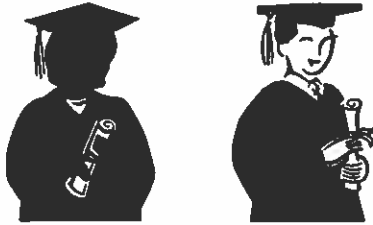
- 1) a female student entering any military branch and placed into a nursing assignment

- New *national* and *regional* scholarships are announced often. Check in at the Career Center.
- Check with your parents about scholarships available through their place of employment. If they ask their human resource department, they should be able to tell them if there are any. If your parents belong to a union, have them check out that source as well.
- Check with your Pastor, Minister or Rabbi- many faith based organizations offer scholarships.
