EASTERN IOWA LIGHT AND POWER COOPERATIVE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

A total of 20 scholarships are available from Eastern Iowa Light & Power Cooperative.

Fifteen \$1,000 scholarships can be used to help defray the costs of attending any four-year college or university, and for students planning to attend a community college and then transferring to a four-year college or university to finish their degree. The five \$1,000 scholarships are awarded to students planning to pursue a trade-related degree at a community college, technical school or power line school.

To be eligible for the Cooperative scholarship program:

- ✓ A student must currently be a high school senior.
- ✓ The student's parents or guardians must be members of Eastern Iowa Light & Power Cooperative.
- ✓ Children of Cooperative employees and directors are eligible.

To be considered for a scholarship a student must supply the Cooperative with:

- ✓ A completed application form.
- ✓ One letter of recommendation from a teacher or school administrator.
- ✓ A 250-word explanation from the student detailing their career goals and how the Cooperative scholarship will help them meet those goals.
- ✓ A transcript of the student's high school grades (does not need to be official).
- ✓ A wallet-size, color head and shoulders photograph of the student.

Scholarship application forms will be available by mail, from the Cooperative web site, www.easterniowa.com, or at any Cooperative service center. All scholarship applications must be postmarked or delivered to a Cooperative service center by March 15, 2019 to be eligible.

Eastern Iowa Light & Power Cooperative is a rural electric distribution cooperative in Iowa, serving more than 18,000 members in 12 eastern Iowa counties. Eastern Iowa Light & Power Cooperative operates service centers in DeWitt, Lone Tree, Wapello and Wilton.

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Dear Scholarship Applicant:

We are happy that you are seeking one of the scholarships and urge you to return the required information as soon as possible for evaluation by the judges. The **deadline is Friday, March 15, 2019** but I would urge you to submit the data sooner.

For a student to be eligible for the scholarship program they must be graduating from high school in 2019 and their parents or guardian must be an Eastern Iowa Light and Power Cooperative member.

Please make certain your Cooperative scholarship application package includes the following:

- Completed application form.
- One letter of recommendation from one teacher.
- A 250-word explanation from you as to what your career goals are and how the Cooperative scholarship will help you meet your goals.
- A transcript of your high school grades (does not need to be official).
- A color head and shoulders photograph of the student.

As indicated by the announcement in the *Current News*, 15 scholarship winners will receive a \$1,000 award that can be used to help defray the costs of attending any accredited college or university; and 5 \$1000 scholarships will be awarded for students planning to pursue a trade-related degree at a community college, technical school or power line school.


The judges are not associated with the Cooperative.
