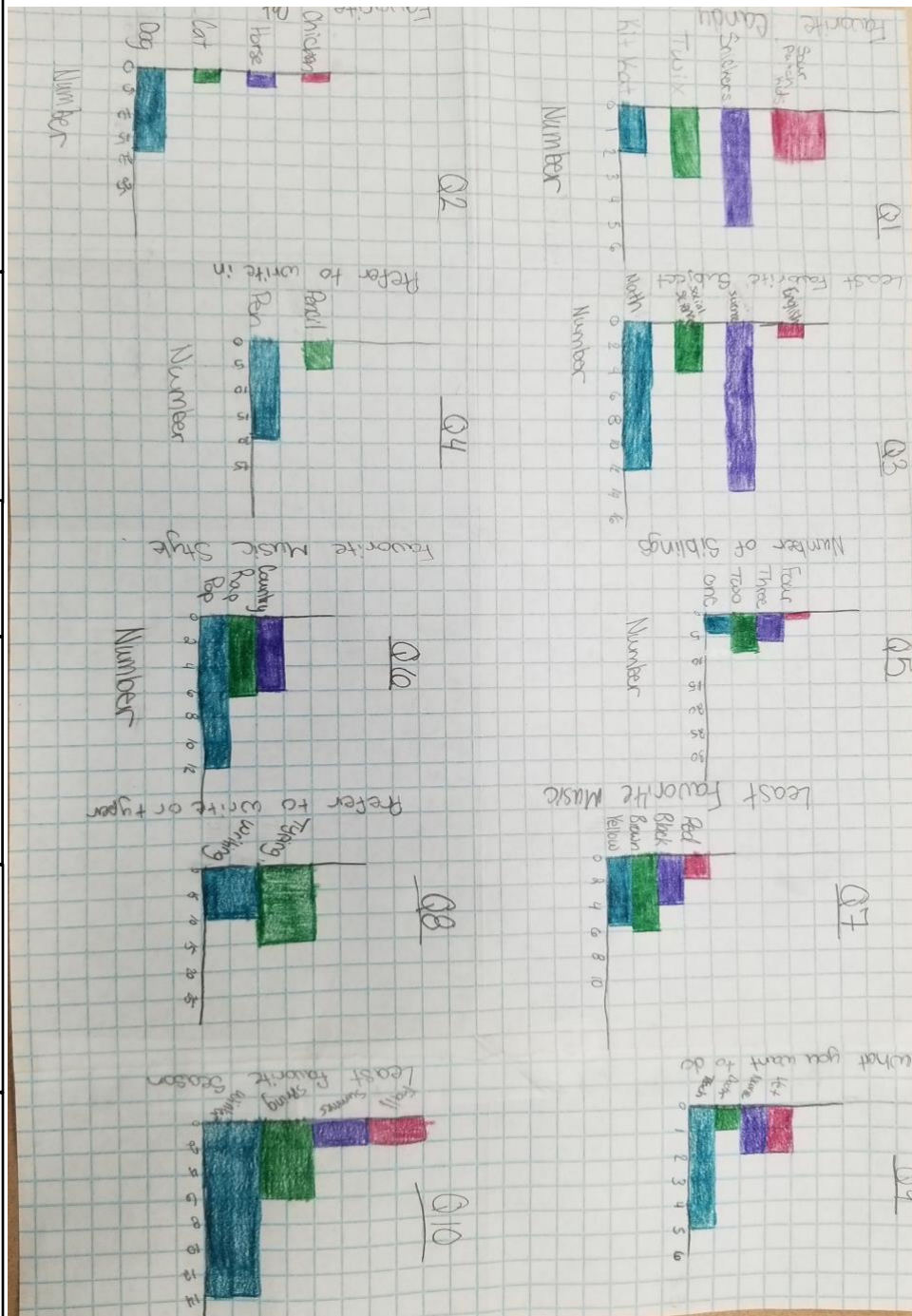

CAROLINA

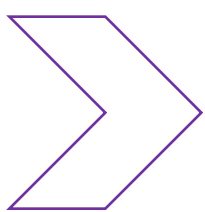
1. Yes, because it's a school that welcomes everybody and they are all very connected to each other.

3. Listening to music, hanging out with friends, and cooking and baking.



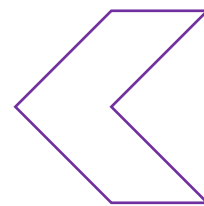
ALEXA
