

Important AP Testing information

May 2-19 Patriot Point; Patriot Point Classroom

- **No electronic devices are allowed inside the testing room.** This includes but is not limited to phones, smartwatches, fitness trackers, wearable technology, cameras, recording or listening devices, or any other type of electronic or communication device. No laptops, tablets or Bluetooth devices.
 - If a student is observed with any of these devices during testing or during breaks, the student will be dismissed from the exam room and the device will be confiscated. The score will be canceled, no retest will be permitted, and will be permanently barred from all AP testing in current and future years.
 - If a student posts to any form of social media during the exam, the student's score will be canceled, no retest will be permitted, and the student will be permanently barred from all AP testing in current and future years.
- **Arrival time:** You must arrive **45 minutes** prior to your test.
 - 8 AM tests need to arrive at 7:15 am
 - 12 PM tests need to arrive at 11:15 am
- **Bring with you:**
 - **Must have photo ID (either school ID or driver's license)**
 - Several No. 2 sharpened pencils with erasers
 - Pens with black or dark blue ink only
 - AP Physics: straight edge or ruler
 - Approved calculators (2 recommended) for AP Biology, Calculus AB and BC, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics, or Statistics. Calculator policy is located <https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/exam-administration-ordering-scores/administering-exams/on-exam-day/calculator-policy>
 - Dress in layers
 - You may bring a bottle of water and a light snack to eat outside of the testing room
- **Do NOT bring with you:**
 - Highlighters, colored pencils, electronic device, compasses, scratch paper, reference guide, or clothing with subject related material.
 - Books, reference guides, notes, compasses, protractors, mechanical pencils, pencils that are not No. 2, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or colored pencils.
 - Scratch paper
 - Watches that beep, make a noise or have an alarm
 - Computers or calculators that are not approved
 - Reference guides, keyboard maps or other typing instructions
 - Ear plugs, clothing or shoes with subject-related information
 - Food or drink may be kept under your desk until break
- **ON THE DAY OF YOUR TEST, YOU WILL BE EXCUSED FROM ALL OF YOUR CLASSES**
 - If you are taking an AM exam, you must leave campus as soon as your exam is over.
 - If you are taking a PM exam, do not arrive any earlier than 11:15 am.
