## THOMAS DOWNEY HIGH SCHOOL SITE SPECIFIC RULES & REGULATIONS

### A. STUDENT CONDUCT CODE, 7-12:

Any dress, grooming, or appearance, which disrupts, or tends to disrupt the educational process, or affect the health or safety of individuals, shall be prohibited (Education Code 48900, subsection k; 35161, 35183, 35291.5, 35294.1; C.A.C. title V, Section 302; and Board Policy 5135, 5135.1, and 5137.

- Any attire/paraphernalia/symbol that signifies gang affiliation will not be allowed on campus.
- Any attire/paraphernalia/symbol that displays a logo or other message promoting alcohol or controlled substances, promoting violence, illegal activity, or relating to gangs may not be worn on campus.
- Any attire reflecting visual sexual harassment.

# B. SUPERINTENDENTS DIRECTIVE THAT COMPLIES WITH BOARD POLICY 5135 RELATED TO GANG ACTIVITY:

Students may not wear or possess hats, caps, or other headgear during school hours at school sites except as specifically authorized by a school official for such school activities at athletics and theatrical performances or other approved personal reasons such as health needs.

### C. PROHIBITED/ GANG RELATED APPAREL (Agreed upon by the School Safety Committee):

- Tank top undershirts and/or any inappropriate shirts
- No Web Belts- All Colors; with or without punched out buckles
- No red or blue hair accessories
- No leather or batting gloves
- No steel toe boots
- No chains such as belt or wallet, etc.
- No "rags", cloths, towels or shirts of any type or color around the neck
- No South Side, North Side, East Side, West Side, or area codes or other 'territory' identifiers
- No solid red or blue shirts
- · No Nike Cortez shoes
- No knee high socks with shorts worn to the knees
- No Nor-Cal, So-Cal, SKIN Industries, South Pole Attire (in any combination of red or blue)
- No Fatal brand clothing, Famous Stars and Straps or Marilyn Monroe shirts
- No Sacramento Kings jerseys (S.K.=Scrap Killers), Chicago Bulls or Last Kings attire
- · No NFL lanyards
- No Cali Republic/Cali Life shirts with a red star
- No over-sized or "too tall" shirts
- No solid black shirts worn with solid black pants
- Memorial shirts must be pre-approved by administration
- No three-point or five-point crowns
- · No rosaries of any type
- No LRG Shirts with pictures or references to trees
- No red or blue sports jerseys for students on the at-risk list. No red or blue clothing of any type if the student is on the at-risk list. <u>ALL shades of red and blue</u>

#### D. OTHER PROHIBITED OBJECTS:

- Permanent markers, paint pens or other tagging materials
- Glass bottles or containers
- E. ALL STUDENTS WHO LEAVE THE SCHOOL PREMISES DURING THE SCHOOL DAY AND RETURN ARE SUBJECT TO SEARCH. ANY STUDENT WHO IS OUT OF BOUNDS WITHIN THE SCHOOL CAMPUS IS SUBJECT TO SEARCH.
