STUDENT SUCCESS TEAM

Teachers, parents, staff and social service personnel are welcome to request an schedule a Student Success Team (SST) meeting to support students and families. Our Student Success Team meets twice a month and occasionally an emergency meeting will be schedule to be hold immediately to dealt with high risk cases. The purpose of these meetings is to help parents, children and faculty members to assist in developing goals to improve academic welfare, psychological and emotional state of mind for our students. Every meeting is completely confidential. Referrals will be made according to the needs of the student and family.

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Counseling Services

The Healthy Start Program works in collaboration with the Center for Human Services Agency to provide mental health services to our students. Our office has a counselor two days a week. If you feel that your children are in need of this type of services, ask the School office or visit our Healthy Start Family Resource Center to request services.

CPR & First Aid Training

This program will help you benefit from classes focused on health, nutrition and family emergencies.

The Latino Family Literacy

Project

This program helps parents to improve family reading, reading comprehension and get the families involved in the school community.
