List I—only the core curriculum classes as defined in the state framework which must integrate intellectually and academically challenging material, substantial amounts of reading, writing, critical thinking, and problem solving skills and individual lab work in the case of science. They must also fulfill college preparatory requirements. College courses of equivalent or greater intellectual and academic rigor are on List I, as are sheltered/bilingual sections of the following courses:

Dance Production does not count unless it is taken as a fine art. No more than 5 credits of ROP and WEX courses each semester count toward CSF membership.
