PAINTER II

OVERALL RESPONSIBILITY

Under general direction, provide assistance and leadership. Assume responsibility for planning and estimating various school facilities projects.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Prepare and paint interior/exterior of buildings, equipment, structures, and furniture. Glaze/cut glass and plastic for window pane replacement.
- 2. Repair, replace and install signs, windows, black-out curtains, and venetian blinds.
- 3. Prepare labor and material estimates, layouts, and sketches for work projects.
- 4. Operate and maintain various power and hand tools. Set up ladders and scaffolding for paint preparation, etc.
- 5. Assist, inspect, and coordinate ordering of materials. Work with other departments and outside agencies when necessary.
- 6. Prepare/maintain time and material reports, and necessary records in an orderly, accurate, and timely manner.
- 7. Assist in the preparation, inspection, and review of plans, jobs, bids, safety programs, and repair projects.
- 8. Read and interpret construction drawings, specification plans, and blueprints. Maintain all necessary records and reports.
- 9. Lead/assist in the work of painters and helpers.
- 10. Perform basic arithmetic calculations with speed and accuracy.
- 11. Adhere to State, County, and District safety codes and procedures.
- 12. Wear Modesto City Schools' identification during assigned work hours (e.g., badge or Modesto City Schools' shirt).
- 13. Wear apron, breathing apparatus, face protector, shoes, eye goggles, rubber gloves, protective coveralls, and hearing protectors as directed
- 14. Maintain a valid California Driver's License Class C.
- 15. Maintain participation in CA DMV Assessment System/Automatic Pull Program.
- 16. Effectively communicate and maintain cooperative relationships with those contacted in the course of work.
- 17. Perform other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge/Ability

Minimum Requirements:

Knowledge of equipment safety codes and procedures.

Knowledge/ability in the use and application of materials, tools, equipment, and methods used in painting.

Knowledge of and ability to perform data entry functions.

Ability to read blueprints and to work according to plans and specifications.

Ability to understand and implement oral and written directions in English.

Ability to accurately perform basic arithmetic calculations with speed and accuracy.

Ability to set up and work from ladders and scaffolding.

Experience

Minimum Requirement:

Four (4) years experience as a painter or forty-eight (48) months experience as a painter acquired through an accredited apprenticeship program, skill training program, or general experience.

Education

Minimum Requirement:

Graduation from high school or General Education Development (GED) Certificate or California High School Proficiency Examination (CHSPE) Certificate.

License/Certificate

Valid California Driver's License - Class C

Must provide a DMV printout within five (5) work days of offer of employment.

Physical Characteristics:

With or Without the Use of Aids:

Sufficient vision to read printed material and drive and operate equipment.

Sufficient depth perception. Sufficient color acuity.

Sufficient hearing to hear work area noise and normal conversation in person and on the telephone.

Ability to speak in a voice that can be clearly heard and understood on the telephone and in face-to-face conversations and at the work site.

Ability to reach horizontally and vertically with arms. Sufficient dexterity to operate hand and power tools requiring strength and coordination, manipulate small objects, print or write legibly, operate precision tools, and make minute repairs.

Sufficient physical ability, strength, mobility, and stamina to drive a vehicle, climb ladders, bend, stretch, stand, kneel, walk, stoop, crawl, and extend legs.

Sufficient physical ability, strength, mobility, and stamina to perform heavy physical labor in hot, cold, and inclement weather conditions.

Sufficient physical ability, strength, balance, and stamina to tolerate working on rooftops, scaffolds, and ladders at heights up to 50 feet, sometimes in precarious positions.

Sufficient physical ability, strength, mobility and stamina to lift, carry, push or pull objects which may frequently exceed 60 pounds in a series of functional tests which clearly simulates the work environment.

Physical tolerance to chemical odors, paint spray, and a variety of chemicals.

Pre-Employment Physical Examination

A physical and tuberculosis examination is required as a condition of employment. Examinations shall be administered by a District provider and be at the District's expense. Individuals must evidence ability to perform physical requirements of position and test negative for tuberculosis.
