

MINUTES OF THE **Public Hearing on Staunton's Proposed Tax Levy for 2018**
MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF STAUNTON COMMUNITY UNIT
DISTRICT #6, Macoupin and Madison Counties, Illinois, held in the school Library on Monday,
December 17th, 2018 at 6:45 p.m.

I. Call to Order

Vice President John Renner called the Public Hearing on Staunton's Proposed Tax Levy for 2018 to order at 6:45 pm in the school Library.

II. Conduct Public Hearing on Proposed Tax Levy for 2018

Mr. Cox told the guests and the Board that the corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2017 were \$3,366,098.00. The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2018 are \$3,830,507.00. This represents a 13.8% increase over the previous year. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2017 were \$152,559.00. The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2018 are \$154,095.00. This represents a 1.01% increase over the previous year. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2017 were \$3,518,657.00. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2018 are \$3,984,682.00. This represents a 13.24% increase over the previous year. Mr. Cox told the Board that we did **not** raise taxes listed by the amount in the levy. Instead, in the unlikely event that taxes would raise by the listed amount, the District would collect the money it is entitled to receive.

With no questions nor comments from the public nor the Board, the Hearing adjourned at 6:52 p.m.
