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AWARDS

Procedures: Scholarship, Athletics, Arts, and Citizenship

Scholarship

- A. Students in grades 6, 7, and 8 shall be recognized at the end of each marking period in:
  - 1. Honor Roll (90% or above in all core classes); and
  - 2. Principal's honor roll (92% or above in all classes including Related Arts).
- B. Students in grades 4 through 7 shall be recognized at the end of the year at the grade level assemblies for achievement, improvement and effort. At each level, teachers shall meet to discuss awards to guarantee balance and that as many children are recognized as possible. Children shall be awarded certificates.
- C. Graduating students shall be recognized in all aspects of the curriculum. See attachments "Graduation Award" for procedures. Honor graduates are determined using the criteria for the Presidential Education Awards. See attachment "Honor Graduates." At the end of the second marking period, the guidance counselor examines the cumulative records of those eighth graders who have met the required criteria in order to be named the presidential scholar.

Athletics

Students in grades 6 through 8 who have participated in interscholastic sports may be recognized at an end-of-the-year special athletic awards assembly.

Arts and Citizenship

These awards are chosen using the same procedures described under scholarship.
