REMINDER – The Arkansas Department of Education (ADE) provides sample budgets on their website sometime prior to the deadline for the budget publication as required by A.C.A. §6-13-622.

To assist school districts that want to adopt and publish the budget prior to the samples being available, we will make available a <u>suggested</u> sample for the Districts with no millage change from the previous year. The statutory part of the budget/publication is the text portion only, not the budget numbers. Before the provided budget/ballot is passed and published, please check the millage for accuracy. The sample provided is without legal counsel, therefore First Security Beardsley Public Finance will not be responsible for any litigation pertaining to the sample budget or corresponding ballot.

Attached to this cover are the following: (1) Checklist of "Significant Dates for 2013 Election" prepared by the Friday Law Firm; (2) 2013 Election instructions prepared by FS Beardsley Public Finance; (3) Suggested Motion Sheet; (4) Proposed Budget of Expenditures for 2014-2015; (5) a corresponding Sample Ballot; Sample Notice of Annual School Election and Sample Notice of Polling Sites.

In the preparation for the annual school election we have attached a sample of the two required notices. You will need to check with the County Election Commission for a list of the Polling Sites to be used in completing both Notices before publication. Please check the millage for accuracy prior to publication.

The sample provided is without legal counsel, therefore First Security Beardsley Public Finance will not be responsible for any litigation pertaining to the sample Notice of Annual School Election or the sample Notice of Polling Sites.

#### SIGNIFICANT DATES FOR 2013 SCHOOL ELECTION

A.C.A. ' 6-14-102 sets the third Tuesday in September as the date of the annual school election. For 2013, the date is Tuesday, September 17.

Amendments 40 and 74 require that the budget be published <u>not later</u> than 60 days before the election. The deadline would be Thursday, July 18.

Petitions to run for Director must be filed with the County Clerk at least 70 days before the election (A.C.A. ' 6-14-111(e)).

Absentee ballots must be on file at the County Clerk=s office not less than 47 days before the election (A.C.A. ' 7-5-407(a)). The deadline would be Thursday, August 1.

The ballot should provide space for write-in candidates if any write-in candidate has filed with the County Clerk not later than <u>70</u> days before the election (A.C.A. '6-14-111(g)).

A.C.A. '6-14-109 requires Notice of Election to be published once a week for three weeks, the first publication to be at least 20 days before the election. The deadline would be August 28.

Notice of polling places must be published one time not more than 10 days and not less than 3 days prior to the election (A.C.A. '6-14-106(d)). Publish in a newspaper or newspapers with general circulation in all counties in which any part of the territory of the district is located. A.C.A. '6-14-115(a) requires the County Board of Election Commissioners, no earlier than forty-eight (48) hours and not later than ten (10) days after the election, to ascertain and declare the results of the election and file the certification of election and a sample ballot with the County Clerk. The deadline could be between September 7 and September 14.

In the event that either (1) there are more than two candidates for school director and no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast, or (2) a tie vote for a school director position, a run-off election between the two highest candidates is held three weeks following the annual election (A.C.A. ' 6-14-121).

# 2013 Election Suggestions related to the attached documents and other documents to be published

- (1) Verify the millage information on the budget and ballot. The budget and ballot should be identical other than the opening paragraph.
- (2) Adopt the attached proposed budget. Have the President and Secretary execute the budget. Give or send the budget to a newspaper(s) published in all Counties that have polling sites for the District.
- (3) Forward the ballot to the County Election Commission. If the District has polling sites in more than one county, make sure the main County Election Commission is coordinating with all of the other Election Commissions.
- (4) In most counties, the County Election Commission is no longer making sure the "Notice of Annual School Election" or "Notice of Polling Sites" is being published. Make sure the District clearly understands who is preparing and publishing the two Notices. If the District is going to handle the preparation and publication of the Notices and do not have the forms for the Notice of Annual School Election and the Notice of Polling Sites, please contact our office for assistance.
- (5) Pay close attention to the dates listed by the Friday Law Firm. Several time frames were changed during the recent legislative session.

## PROPOSED BUDGET OF EXPENDITURES WITH TAX LEVY FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014 to and including June 30, 2015

The Board of Directors of Deer/Mount Judea School District No. 21 of Newton County, Arkansas, in compliance with the requirements of Amendments No. 40 and No. 74 to the Constitution of the State of Arkansas and of Ark. Code Ann. § 6-13-622 has prepared, approved and hereby makes public the proposed budget of expenditures, together with the tax rate, as follows:

1.	Salary Fund Expenditures	\$ 2,512,000
2.	Instructional Expense	\$ 1,007,000
3.	Maintenance & Operation Expense	\$ 591,000
4.	Dedicated M & O Expense	\$ 0

To provide for the foregoing proposed budget of expenditures, the Board of Directors proposes a total school tax rate (state and local) of 33.0 mills on the dollar of the assessed value of taxable property located in this School District. The proposed tax includes the uniform rate of tax (the "Statewide Uniform Rate") to be collected on all taxable property in the State and remitted to the State Treasurer pursuant to Amendment No. 74 to the Arkansas Constitution to be used solely for maintenance and operation of schools in the State. As provided in Amendment No. 74, the Statewide Uniform Rate replaces a portion of the existing rate of tax levied by this School District and available for maintenance and operation of schools in this District. The total proposed school tax levy of 33.0 mills includes 25.0 mills specifically voted for general maintenance and operation and 8.0 mills voted for debt service previously voted as a continuing levy pledged for the retirement of existing bonded indebtedness. The surplus revenues produced each year by debt service millage may be used by the District for other school purposes.

The total proposed school tax levy of 33.0 mills represents the same rate presently being levied.
